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Lesson Plan for MEP Video Lessons

Teacher's Name : Teng Hua Kneebone
Date of lesson: Wednesday 1st May
Year 7
Number of students : 32 students (15 boys, 17 girls)
Communicative aims (speaking): By the end of the lesson, students will be able to say 9 words about food and drink; some of the students will be able to recognise all the characters. They should also be able to ask the question 'what do you like to eat/drink?' and answer 'I like to eat...'/ 'I like to drink...'. Some of the students will be able to say what they like to eat/drink and give reasons.
Language aims (grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation): grammar: students will be able to ask questions using 什么. vocabulary: students will be able to say and recognise 9 new words about food and drink Pronunciation: students will be able to pronounce the new words correctly
Skills development (reading, writing, listening): Listening skills: listen for the gist: students practice listening to the key words in the sentences. Reading skills: There will be 2 activities to develop students reading skills, one will be the mini-plenary after the students have learned the new vocabulary; the other will be the Dictogloss activity, when students need to read and share the sentences within their group members. Writing: There will be two activities for practicing writing skills, one will be to practice writing the characters 吃 and 喝; the other will be the Dictogloss activity, where students will be asked to reconstruct the sentences after they listen and take notes.
Materials and aids to be used: Jinbu 1 text book; images from the internet, PPT; youtube video
Lesson content: This is the first lesson to start unit 5 in the Jinbu text book. Therefore, students will basically learn 9 new words about food and drink, and some key words for this topic, such as 吃 and 喝。 On this basis, students will use the new words and their previous knowledge to further develop their language skills, including listening, speaking and recognition of characters.

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Group profile (e.g. what is this class normally like? Are there specific pupils who like to speak up, etc):

The class is generally very good but sometimes listening is an issue. Many of the students are happy to ask and answer questions during lessons.
