You are a detector working for Scotland Yard London Office. A Chinese man is reported missing from his hotel room in London for two days by now. You are called in to check the possible crime scene. You need to write a report of a description what the hotel room look like **in Chinese** (see picture below) to keep Chinese Embassy informed and for any further investigation.



You must cover:

- What furniture are there in the room;
- Description of the room using adjectives;
- Using prepositions to describe the room, ie. next to the bed, there is two lamps;
- Avoid using “I think” as this is a formal report.

Main errors occurred when using complex structures; ○ Used more than three adjectives, and all correctly used; ○ Used at least three out of 不但...而且, 又...又..., 除了...还 and 也; ○ Used two out of 很, 非常 or ...极了 for adjectives. ○ Used three of the four prepositions to describe the room correctly, in, on, under and next to; ○ Used past time, ie. yesterday, two days ago etc

Mistakes mainly occurred in complex structures; ○ Used at least three adjectives, and all correctly used; ○ Used at least two out of 不但...而且, 又...又..., 除了...还 and 也; ○ Used 很 and one of 非常 or ...极了 for adjectives. ○ Used two of the four prepositions to describe the room correctly, in, on, under and next to;
D-E	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Cover most bullet points above; ○ There were some mistakes on sentence structures, including one or two simple sentence structure errors; ○ Used at least three adjectives; ○ Used 很 for adjectives. ○ Used one of the four prepositions to describe the room correctly, in, on, under and next to;

Tips to achieve A or above: Fully describe the picture. *Don't miss any details. Use dictionary to check for some new words but try not to be too ambitious when coming to form new sentence structures. Make sure you don't make mistakes on simple sentence structures, like S adjective. Most important, try to connect your sentences using complex structures.*

to discover – 发现 (fā xiàn)

two days ago – 两天前 (liǎng tiān qián)

blood – 血 (xiě)

messy – 乱 (luàn)
