Task 1 revise the grammar from Lesson 1. Reshuffle the sentences into the correct order.

1. 动物园票的买好我今天了
2. 我好准备钱去了电影院
3. 双一运动鞋都我买没
4. 一点儿咖啡喝也都今天没老师

Task 2 learn the grammar: the accompanying action: **verb 1 着 + verb 2**. Note that the first verb (followed by 着) describes the state; the second verb is the action verb. In this case, the "-ing" translation can be useful for the state.

If you want to make a sentence where both verbs are action verbs (neither is truly a state), then you don't want this pattern; you want 一边……, 一边…… (yībiān..., yībiān...).

例 1: 她喜欢站着吃饭。"standing + eat = eating while standing" (She likes to eat standing up.)

例 2: 他笑着说“对不起”。"smiling + say = saying "I'm sorry" while smiling (Smiling, he said, "I'm sorry.")
